

Grant Awards - 2011

Brazil - Sister Cervina Cadore

Refurbishing building that produces yogurt \$2000.00

This project aims to benefit 500 school children as well as 25 families, where the women are the main breadwinners. Yogurt is produced by the women thus providing a livelihood for their families and is then sold to the municipality for school lunches. This grant will provide needed improvements to the yogurt production building, bringing it up to code.

Ghana - Sister Maria Rojaman

Water tank for Holy Family High School \$2000.00

Holy Family Senior High School, staffed by three Sisters of St. Joseph of Lyon, was established in January 2009 to serve the poor children of the Diocese of Hamile. The water tank will allow more time for the students to attend to studies rather than going from one borehole to another to fetch water for all to use.



Haiti - Sister Eunice Tassone

Earth Embankment Project \$3820.00

In preparation for building a medical facility in Haiti's Central Plateau region, a new road is a key ingredient of the plan. This grant will sustain the new road by terracing it with vetiver grass in order to prevent erosion, thus allowing for the transport of building materials for the hospital. Additionally vetiver grass can be turned into a commercial cash crop, the value of which has endless potential for the Haitian people.

India - Sister Philomina Pichappilly

Drilling of Three Wells \$5000.00

This project in Vandevi Nagar will supply water for the whole village – 300 families numbering 1500 people. The people of the village will identify the locations for the wells, contribute labor, and oversee the implementation and ongoing maintenance of the project.

India - Sister Jolly Abraham

Rain Water Harvesting \$5000.00

St. Joseph School meets the educational needs of tribal girls (forest dwellers) in Sur, India. Presently there is only one well to service this area which is not sufficient for daily use. As a consequence the children suffer from various water borne diseases. This grant will fund the Rain Water Harvesting System allowing 100 girls the opportunity to have potable water.

India - Sister Dorothy Beck

Water Harvesting \$4180.00

The water level in the wells in the forest villages of Nimawara and Pili Karar subsides by March annually and people have to wander far and wide looking for drinking water. This grant will allow for the deepening of ponds so that water will be available for an additional two months of the year.

Mozambique - Sister Luiza Rodrigues

Cistern for Rain Water \$5000.00

The majority of people in Mumo, Mozambique get by on one meal per day and survive on two local products: dried manioc and corn flour. All suffer from a lack of water. This grant will enable the building of a water cistern at a school thus serving both the students as well as the general population of the area. This project will also benefit elderly women who are accustomed to traveling to the river at night to obtain water.
